For ease of coordinating travel to and from the airport, we recommend you use DTW, Detroit Metropolitan airport for air travel.

Please book a morning flight, if possible, on Friday April 17, 2009. This will enable you to rebook to a later flight in the day in case of flight cancellations due to weather or other circumstances beyond your control, without having to miss the entire conclave.

If you are taking the Amtrak train from the west, we recommend you get off in Dearborn, MI. If you are taking the Amtrak from the east, book tickets to the Detroit Train Station.

On Sunday April 19, please schedule your departure after 4pm. We will have a bus going to the airport arriving at the airport at 2:30pm. We will try and coordinate a drop-off at the Amtrak station as well if it is needed.
